Applications are now open for the TEQSA Register of Experts.

The Tertiary Education Quality and Standards Agency (TEQSA) today opened the application period for its Register of Experts.

TEQSA Chief Commissioner, Dr Carol Nicoll, said that the Register would play a valuable role in helping the Agency meet its regulatory obligations.

“The Register will allow us to draw from a pool of specialist knowledge, from both within and outside the higher education sector, for advice on a range of our regulatory activities, from registration and re-registration processes to quality assessment,” said Dr Nicoll.
