The Tertiary Education Quality and Standards Agency (TEQSA) has completed its enquiries regarding an admissions irregularity at the University of Queensland.

TEQSA is satisfied with the actions taken by the University to revise its special admissions policies and processes.

The scope of TEQSA's enquiries was defined by the TEQSA Act 2011 and the Threshold Standards.

TEQSA undertook a thorough and detailed review of the information provided by the University. This information outlined the actions the University has taken to ensure that there are appropriate checks and balances in its special admissions processes.

TEQSA will continue to monitor the corporate and academic governance activities of all higher education providers to ensure the requirements of the Threshold Standards are met.
